

Parking Lot Resurfacing

June 3-4, 2019 (Raindate: June 10-11) The parking lot is going to be resurfaced on June 3 and 4 weather permitting. (If it rains that week, the work will be postponed to the following Monday and Tuesday.) In addition to putting down two seal coats, the parking lines will be repainted, directional arrows will be added and handicap parking will be consolidated near the wheelchair access.
