Speakers:

Bill Bateman (TeachBeyond) - A retired educator who firsthand sees the need and value of Transformational Education. After 13 years on the mission field and then 12 years as a Missions Pastor he and his wife Debby returned to Black Forest Academy for one year in a different role – dorm parenting. For the last few years, he has worked as a Church Relations Coach – to be explained here this morning.

Dr. Jim Arcieri, Director BFC Board of Missions: Born and raised in Pennington NJ. Jim has been a Church Planter for PCA, Headmaster of StoneBridge School, Pastor of Community Bible Fellowship Church in Red Hill PA, BFC Board of Church Extension, BFC Church Health Committee and Board Member of the Mission Seminary. Jim is also a musician – professional level Bass Guitar and plays with The Swing Shift (10-piece swing band)

Jerry Moyer - Was the assistant pastor at Grace between 1991-1996. Jerry and his wife Caroline left Grace church to be church planters in Paris, France. While participating in several church planting projects Jerry became the France Field Director and most recently Europe Area Director. Since 2018, Carolyn has also been interim director for World Team Australia. This has taken them back and forth between the two continents. Their home is in the town of Magny les Hameaux where their greatest joy is bringing the gospel within reach of their friends and neighbors

Chris and Becky Merrick - Gifted missionaries who have traveled widely nationally and internationally demonstrating their love for the Lord and His adherents by use of their gifts in construction and renovation projects of all descriptions. Becky is a great chef for groups of 5 to 50+. Chris loves to use his gifts to help other missionaries and churches with anything needed in carpentry, electricity, plumbing, painting, etc and development of the plans for putting it all together. In her spare time Becky figures prominently in the Samaritan's Purse Christmas box program and Chris helps. Together they have led many Grace BFC short term mission trips which would have been impossible without them.

Jean Lee - Member of the board for Comfort Foundation. She lived in Russia for a year and now she takes a group there almost every year from her church to show the love of Christ through games, crafts and stories

Beth McMillen - Former Christian elementary school lead teacher who was called by the Lord to use her gifts of administration and helps to create, manage, and sustain a missionary organization - Compassion Corps - in Africa. For the past 15 years, she has worked in the USA in support of partnerships with indigenous Christians in their ministries in Morocco, Mali, Liberia, and Uganda, as well as leading over 35 short-term mission teams to come alongside these Christian leaders in their works of compassion as they share the Gospel and point people to Jesus
